Contractor TCC Checklist

A Document to Review Before Every Road Project

TCC Requirements:

- 1. Rutgers Trained / Certified
- 2. Full Time Position w/ Supervisory Powers
- 3. TCC is to be used as TCC Only. (Not to be used as a Laborer, etc. No Exceptions)
- 4. 24 Hour Availability to Respond To Correct Deficiencies
- 5. Current Information Available on DC-34
- 6. Fix Deficiencies Immediately. If R.E. Advises, TCC Has Two Hours to Repair

Traffic Devices:

- 1. Will Safety Devices Be New or From Prior Job?
- 2. Device Conditions: (Acceptable, Marginal, Unacceptable)
- 3. Drums- Color: Series (Orange, White, Orange)
- 4. Barricades:
 - A) NO Double Sided Panels
 - B) Proper Ballast That Manufacturer Recommends.

Arrow Boards:

- 1. Retro Reflective Tape Around Four Sides
- 2. Four Leg Stands in Lowered Position When In Use
- 3. Tow Chains **Shall** Be Used When Being Towed (NJMV Statute Title 39)

Variable Message Signs:

- 1. Retro Reflective Tape Around Four Sides (Especially during Nighttime use)
- 2. Cones or Drums at the Four Corners ®. E. Directed)
- 3. Proper Height

Advance Warning Signs:

- 1. (AWS) Proper Placement for Line Of Sight View towards Motoring Public
- 2. Anchor Post Heights
- 3. Soil Plates (A must to prevent falling)
- 4. Clear and Concise Messages (No duct tape, Paint, etc.)

*****No Placards, Duct Tape, Altered Message, Etc. On AWS***** (NJDOT Spec)

Pre Cast Concrete Barrier:

- 1. Must Be Like New Condition
- 2. Slack Removed From Connection Key When Placed On Roadway
- 3. Connection Key Securement (Must Be Unable To Remove By Hand) (Stolen, Scrap)
- 4. Pinning Requirements (Class A, B + C)
- 5. Deflection (18")
- 6. No Storage of Equipment Behind An Leaning Against Barrier Curb

Job Site Plans:

- 1. Site Specific?
- 2. NJDOT Standard Specs?
- 3. Combination of Both?
- 4. Detours?
 - A) Need To Be Posted When Detours Are In Use.
 - B) Signs **Shall** Be Removed Or Completely Covered When Not In Use.

Safety Vests:

- 1. Must Meet Current A.N. S. I. Specifications
- 2. All Workers or Other Personnel on Site Are To Wear
- 3. Machine Operators, Truck Drivers, Delivery to Wear Them When Out Of Vehicle on Site

Flagging:

- 1. Stop / Slow Paddle Meeting Proper Height on Staff, Retro reflective, Letters, Etc.
- 2. Advance Warning Signs (AWS) **Shall** be Placed Prior To Work Startup

Dump Trucks and Other Vehicles:

- 1. Conspicuity Tape Meeting the Current NJDOT Specifications on All Trucks /All Equipment.
- 2. Tarpaulins Covering All Loads (Title 39 and Title 49 Laws)
- 3. Spotter for Overhead Obstacles
- 4. Backup Alarms Required

Low Boy Trailers:

- 1. Equipment Must Be Secured With Required Tie Downs.
- 2. (Title 39 + 49 Violations) (Machinery, Pre Cast Concrete Barrier, Etc. ... Anything)

TMA (Truck Mounted Attenuators):

- 1. Conspicuity Tape.
- 2. Meet Current Weight Specifications (20, 000 LBS) (Weight Slip Must Be In Vehicle at All Times)
- 3. Proper Ballast and Proper Securement of Ballast
- 4. Storage of Equipment Not Allowed On TMA Vehicle When Used As **Positive Protection**
- 5. Commercial Registration. *NO IN TRANSIT TAGS* When In Use on Jobsite
- 6. To Be Inspected By R. E. NJSP Prior To Use. (Construction Procedures Handbook)

TMA:

- 1. Prior To Use Must Be Inspected By The R. E. And State Police. (CPH Guidelines)
- 2. If A TMA Is Replaced, R. E. Must Be Notified Of Same and Vehicle Inspected With Inspection Document from NJDOT Construction Procedures Handbook
- 3. Location / Placement of Truck when Utilized For Positive Protection (Most Times Vehicle Is Parked Too Far Away Or Multiple TMA Vehicles Are Needed For Current Conditions And Setup.)

Clear Zone:

- 1. Maintain 30' At All Times From Edge Of Roadway.
- 2. Equipment Storage (Must Be Behind Guide Rail or Protected By A TMA)
- 3. Workers in Work Area Need TMA Protection to Meet Clear Zone Requirements
 - *****Multiple Work Locations Need Multiple TMA'S*****
- 4. No Trucks or Equipment Stored Under Bridges (Violation of Homeland Security + DOT Specs)

Sub-Contractors:

1. **Prime** Is Responsible For All Sub Contractors Actions Regarding Safety Setup

Official Turnarounds or Cut Through On Interstate and State Roadways:

1. Not Allowed To Use Them as Turnarounds (Title 39 Violation) (Emergency Use Only)

Slow Moving Vehicle May Cause Accident

(Unless NJDOT Issues a Letter Indicating Permission)

2. Must Use Official Posted Exits to U-Turn on Job

Traffic Stoppages:

- 1.15 Minute Maximum Allowed. (NJDOT Specs)
- 2. Or, Whatever The Site Plans Direct For Traffic Stoppages

Trooper Request:

- 1. Must Be Made 72 Hours in Advance (NJDOT Spec)
- 2. Must Go Through NJDOT for Approval
- 3. Copy To NJSP And NJDOT GroupWise email

Current Criteria in Place To Request Police:

- 1. Slowdowns of Traffic
- 2. Stoppages of Traffic
- 3. Manual Direction of Traffic At A Traffic Light
- 4. Major Traffic Pattern Changes

R.E. May Request Troopers but May Not Get Them

***State Police Have Recommended:

- 1. A **Minimum** of Two (2) Troopers to Be Requested For Each Direction of Roadway
- 2. When Needed For Slowdowns or Stoppages on Interstate and State Highways

VMS:

1. Make Sure Messages Reflect What Work Is Currently Taking Place (Lane Closure, Traffic Shift, Etc.)

Bridge Demo:

- 1. Protect Motorists from Falling Debris
- 2. Prior Safety Reports and Incident Reports Are On File

Jobsite:

- 1. Maintain a Neat Appearance
- 2. Roadway Lighting to Be Maintained
- 3. Is Subject To Inspections 24 Hours A Day
- 4. TCP Reviews

**** R.E. To Be Notified When Inspections Are Going To Take Place by The TCC So That He May Go Along To Observe Same

Temporary Lane Closures:

- 1. Place AWS (2 Miles, 1 Mile, Etc. Shall Be Placed Prior To Permanent Mounted
 - AWS: (Additional Signs Too Be Placed Prior To Permanent Mounted Signs)
- 2. Permanent AWS Do Not Count When Performing Closures Outside Of Job Boundaries
- 3. No Lane Closure Merge Tapers Allowed In Site Specific Designed Traffic Lane Shifts

(Forces Vehicles To Cross Solid White Lines. Violation of Title 39 Laws)

***Conflicting AWS to Be Covered Completely

- 1. Bagged (Completely, Opaque) NJDOT Specifications
- 2. No Tape on Sign Face
- 3. No Wood Covers, Etc.

Safety Setup Concerns:

- 1. Any Questions Regarding Safety Setup Shall Be Directed To The R. E.
- 2. The R.E. May Contact the NJSP Construction Unit for Assistance
- ***Concerns Involving Any Local Police Bring To The attention of the R. E.
- ***Notify Local Police If Closing Lanes, Performing Detours, Or Having Any Impact On Traffic Through Their Town Or On Their Roadway, (Call Response Issues, Pursuits, Etc.)

Equipment:

- 1. Must Be Escorted By Contractor
- 2. Flashing Amber Lights (TMA Preferred For Slow Speeds and Positive Protection)
- 3. Low Boy Tractor Trailer to Transport Equipment / Machinery

(Shall Be Properly Secured At All Times NJ Title 39)

Employees:

- 1. Riding On Parts Not Intended For Travel (Title 39 Violation)
- 2. Only Allowed During Lane Closure Device Placement or Pickup

(Drums + Cones, Barricades)

***** (Not During AWS Placement or Safety Check Loops)

- 3. No Driving Against Traffic Flow (Title 39)
- 4. Not to Utilize Center Cuts of Highway as U-Turns (Must Exit) (Title 39)
